About the West Coast Youth Championships

The Sherry Cervi West Coast Youth Championships was established to promote the sport of barrel racing and rodeo to the youth. There will be two classes 12 & Under and 17 & Under. Both classes will be paid out in a 4D format.

Race Qualifications

Contestants must be 17 years of age or under on January 1, 2010 for the 17 & Under class, and 12 years of age or under on January 1, 2010 for the 12 & Under class.

Race Awards

Currently the race has \$2500 in added cash and will be distributed evenly between the 17 & Under and 12 & Under classes. Saddles will be awarded to D winners in each category. 8 Sherry Cervi saddles will be awarded.

Race Rules

Race starts at 7pm both days. Contestants are expected to be ready to run and at the in-gate when their name is called. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. All contestants and their **family members** are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. No level of abuse toward any animal at this event will be allowed. Foul language, misconduct or abusive comments spoken to any Contestant, Spectator, Staff Member or Volunteer will result in immediate contestant disqualification and no refund of entry fees. Contestants are also responsible for traveling companions and family members. All decisions made by the Race Director are final. This event is independent of the Spring Run Classic and requires a separate entry. Contestant can only win one saddle.

About the Scholarship Program

The scholarship program was started to encourage youth riders who wish to compete at the college level and continue their education beyond high school.

Who Qualifies

To qualify for the scholarship program you must be a contestant and compete in both days of the 2010 Sherry Cervi West Coast Youth Championships. All contestants qualify regardless of age.

How Do I Apply

To apply you must have the following:

Entry:

Be entered and participate in both days of the 2010 Sherry Cervi West Coast Youth Championships.

Written Essay:

Submit a written essay on why you feel you should be a recipient [500 words or less].

Letters of Recommendation:

Submit letters from three references, preferably at least one school faculty member. Each reference letter must be written on official stationary [if applicable] to 2010 Sherry Cervi West Coast Youth Championships sealed in an envelope with an original signature.

Transcripts:

Provide a current record of standing [report card].

Submission:

All components must be submitted with your entry to the 2010 Sherry Cervi West Coast Youth Championships. The last day to submit your information is April 10, 2010.

Notification

Recipients will be posted on the Diamond Bar Arena website and will be notified by phone within two months after the event. Scholarships will be paid directly to the schools being attended.
